Within a few hours, he encounters a travelling companion who assists him in some impossible task--gives him a fortune, saves his life, etc. The story ends with the companion disclosing himself as the corpse he had befriended.*

Welcome to the sixth edition of my songbook. After many exhausting hours of research, editing and working with those little chord boxes, it's finally done. It's really easy to use, and a lot more organized than the last edition. There are only ten songs without chords this time (down from 30), and the chord letters stayed over the right words after printing it out this time. (I'm a musician first, an editor second). People in the lot always ask me the same questions. Here are some of the answers:

Does this book have the leads?

First of all, if I was good enough to put Jerry's leads into tablature, I'd be up on the stage, not selling songbooks on the lot. Second, the book would be 500 pages long and I don't have that kind of time to spare. My recommendation for those who want leads: practice for thirty years and maybe you'll be as good as Jerry someday.

Are these the same chords and keys the Dead use?

Some are, some aren't. I intentionally changed Touch of Grey because A is easier than B. It all depends.

Does it have Corinna?

Yes, reluctantly, I put in Corinna...also Liberty, Way To Go Home, and some new covers. Enjoy!
